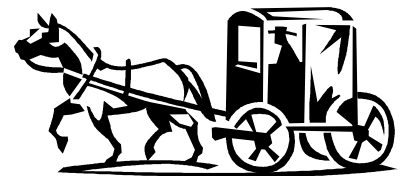

6. Open Mens Driving
7. Open Donkey & Mule Driving
8. Open Draft Driving (Halflingers, Clydes, Belgiums, etc.)

13. Open Youth Obstacle Driving (Drivers 18 & Under - groom/handler required in cart)
14. Open Obstacle Driving
15. Barrel Race Driving (timed event)
16. Cone Weaving Driving (timed event)
17. Drive with your Pet
18. Ride & Drive (Rules posted on day of show)
19. Non-winners Driving (open to any equine/driver combination not winning a blue ribbon in previous classes 1-18 - \$5 fee collected at the gate)
